### Feeding the Children

John 6:1-14



July 25 — 9<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost  
Sermon Title: "Feeding the Children"  
Scripture: John 6:1-14

What is a "narrative sermon?" I discovered that, before I could finish my coursework for ordination, I had to take an "on campus" preaching class – "in-person" instead of online. So, that summer I quickly grabbed one extra preaching course to satisfy the North Georgia Conference expectations. That course was "narrative preaching." Not something I would use most Sundays, but a storytelling approach to a Biblical text. The last two of my narrative sermons were presented by Charlie McLemore (with much thanks from this author). The idea is to "re-present" a familiar Bible story from a different perspective. The Lazarus story told by the runner sent to fetch Jesus, the story of Jerusalem told by one of Noah's grandsons (that was just this month on July 4<sup>th</sup>). And this Sunday's narrative sermon was written by one of my classmates about the feeding of the five thousand told by the little boy (now grown into an old man) who offered the five loaves and two fish.
