September 26 — 18th Sunday after Pentecost in Kingdomtide

Sermon Title: "Lemon Juice from an Orange?"

Scripture: James 3:13 - 4:3, 7-8a (CEB)

Let's consider the "results" or "the outcomes" of faith working in our lives. If we are disciples, followers of Jesus, what does that look like? How we treat each other and how we respond to pressure and stress? What comes out of us reveals what goes into us. What comes out of us reveals what is growing inside. What do you get when you squeeze a Christian? To expect less than Jesus to come out would be like squeezing an orange and expecting lemon juice!

Is the goal of discipleship to be faithful to fulfill Christian duties? Is the goal of discipleship to have the Spirit of wisdom and revelation? Or should we FIRST and FOREMOST know and relate to God as disciples? Something closer to walking in the garden with God in the cool of the day. Do we truly know our calling? Consider this... could discipleship be the process of becoming who Jesus would be if Jesus were me?
