 Sermon Title: "On Your Mark, Get Set, WAIT"  
 Scripture: Revelation 1:4-8

We ought to read Revelation as the reflections of faithful Christians on a broken, baffling world. How we ought to live... is the question that drives Revelation. The "seer of Patmos" that authored Revelation declares (against the wishes of imperial Rome) to a Christian community that with the Lord God, there is always more (...who was, and is, and is to come): more transformation to come than the earth has yet seen, more power and authority than any claimed by earthly rulers, more dignity for God's people than earthly rulers recognize. Revelation is a foretaste of heavenly worship. That means the worship life of the Christian community reflects the work God is doing to transform our world. So, WAIT, there is more to come!
