Sermon Title: "Custodian"

Scripture: Galatians 3:23-29

What's another word for custodian? Most of us would think — janitor. Someone on the cleaning crew. But "custodian" can have other meanings, like one who fills in for a parent as the rule-keeper, the boundary-maker. As a child, we would equate that to a person taking all the fun out of life. Maybe a person lacing life with "ought to" statements, always saying "because I said so." Does Paul equate the Law with THAT definition of a custodian. Let's ask ourselves, when were we old enough that our parents quit supplying a babysitter? Why, do you imagine, were they able to make that decision, that we were mature enough that we no longer needed a custodian? Does that work for faith as well? Do we no longer need the LAW?
