

There will be a six-week Thursday morning Bible Study in the Fellowship Hall from 10:00 – 12:00 beginning on August 4.



July 24 — 8<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost

Sermon Title: "Foolish Treasure"

Scripture: Luke 12:13-21

Prior to coming to Bascomb UMC, I was serving a small church in rural western Georgia. One of the many things I saw there was an abundance of barns. There were barns of all shapes and sizes in all types of condition. Being the "city boy" that I was, I really didn't know much about barns. Remembering what I had seen growing up on TV and at the movies, I thought barns were just a place to keep some of the farm animals. I later learned that barns had multiple uses and one of them was the storage of feed for the farm animals.

In our Scripture reading for this Sunday, Jesus tells the crowd about the "Parable of the Rich Fool." A rich farmer had a bumper crop come in which was too much for the barns he had. He planned to have those barns torn down and have bigger ones built in their place. And after they were built, the rich farmer planned to take life easy and live off what he had.

But the rich farmer found out later that day that was not going to happen. Come find out Sunday to see what happened to the farmer and all that he had coming to him.
