June 18—Father's Day "Our Heavenly Father is Looking for You" - Ezekiel 22: 23-31

"The word of the LORD came to me, saying... I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the gap before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it; but I found no one.

Ezekiel 22:1, 30 (NKJV)

A computer can be programmed to respond at your command. And by conditioning a dog with rewards and punishments, you can teach it to obey. But as a father knows, children are not so easily taught. People have wills and must choose to submit, to follow the instructions of their parents and leaders. Surely discipline is part of the process – boys and girls should know the consequences of disobedience – but there is a choice to be made. They are not animals or *Artificial Intelligence* machines.


God's children must learn to obey their heavenly Father. Created in his image, they have a choice, and the Father allows them to choose.
