"A Welcome Reception" - Matthew 10: 40-42

Couple of questions for you, do you still have a welcome mat outside the front door of your house? If you do, do you still mean that someone is welcome at your house?

From what I can tell, less and less people are using welcome mats per se' or if they are using some type of mat, then it might have some type of saying or some type of artwork on them. You see, it has gotten to a point that there are some people who simply don't want anyone to visit them at home and if someone does, then there is a chance that the homeowners may not be "too welcoming" to their visitors.

Now what I have written may be true at some houses but not at all houses. What about houses of God? What about churches and other houses of God? Jesus speaks to that in our Scripture reading for Sunday. Our reading is only 3 verses long but the word "welcomes" is found 6 different times. That's a lot of times in a little bit of writing. I think Jesus is trying to tell us something.

I believe verse 40 is a great place to start, Jesus said, "Anyone who welcomes you welcomes me, and anyone who welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me." When we are about the work of God and someone welcomes us, they also welcome Jesus and God, our heavenly Father.

In these coming days, may our words and deeds indeed look like we are about the work of God, so that others may see that we're not alone.
