"The Inner Struggle" - Romans 7: 15-25

"For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh.

For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to

carry it out." (Romans 7:18)

Our passage for this week may resonate with some of you. The Apostle Paul logically explains how humanity often lives out their lives. They don't want to sin. They don't want to do what is wrong to the law of Moses. And they don't want to be consider weak because they can't seem to do what is right.

Sound familiar? It might sound familiar because we too don't want to be seen as weak along with the other two reasons written. We truly want to love God and our neighbors but there something within us that keeps us from doing what is right in the eyes of God. What is it that stops us from sinning?

The better question is, "Who will stop me from sinning?" And then Paul added another question for us to consider, "Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death?" (Romans 7:24) Of course, we know the answer. We all know the answer. But still, it doesn't stop us from sinning again and again, does it?

What a struggle Paul creates for us in our reading for Sunday. A struggle that will stay with us for the rest of our lives. The good news is that we have someone on our side for the rest of our lives. I'll let Paul tell us the who, "Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself serve the law of God with my mind, but with my flesh I serve the law of sin." (Romans 7:25)
