July 23—VBS Sunday "What a Family" - Romans 8: 12-25

"For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God. The Spirit you received does not make you slaves, so that you live in fear again; rather, the Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children."

What are some of your earliest memories of God and what you were taught about God? As I looked back after reading our passage for this week, I was taught God was always watching us and that God would know whenever we did something bad. And if we didn't confess our sins to the priest or God, then we could be punished by God in some form or fashion.

It wasn't until I started listening to Christian radio and began attending a United Methodist Church that I began to see God, our Heavenly Father, as a loving Father, not just as one type of father watching me and waiting for me to sin so they could punish me. It was my walk with Christ that changed all of that. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, I became a "child of God," and no longer had to worry about being afraid of a wrathful, angry God.
