

Last Sunday, August 6th, after the 11AM service, our church's Administrative Council, met to vote on whether or not the church membership should vote on disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church. After a brief explanation of the voting procedure and who was eligible to vote by Chairperson Kevin Smith, the vote took place. By a narrow margin of 7 to 6, the Church Council voted "no" to the church wide vote by membership which then meant at that time our church would no longer pursue disaffiliation from the UMC.

Needless to say, the vote by the Council has caused a great deal of strife within our congregation. But this vote does not define who Bascomb has been, who it is now or who we will continue to be in the future. Those of us who are remaining will be asked to serve and to give a great deal for our church's work in our community. Several members of our church have asked if Bascomb will become part of the "Lighthouse" program, in the North Georgia Conference, as we seek to minister to the remaining United Methodists and others in our area.

This week's Scripture reading for Sunday is Matthew's account of the disciples trying to cross a lake during a storm. After Jesus' arrival by walking on the water to the disciples' boat, Peter asked Jesus to "call him" so he could walk on the water to Jesus. When Peter took his eyes off of Jesus and looked at the winds around him, he began to sink into the water.

May Peter's example be a reminder to us in the coming days, weeks, and months, that we need to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus as we move forward to our call to love and serve all who cross our paths wherever this may take place.
