
UWF Meeting Update

Bascomb Preschool Planning Scholastic Book Fair

Mark your calendars for the week of October 16-20 when the preschool will host a fair downstairs in the big room! Shopping will be open during the hours of 8:30-10:00 and at 1:00 to 2:00 each day (Monday-Friday). The preschool will also open the book fair for shopping during the Sunday before the fair opens to the preschool, so check it out on October 15 after the 10:00 a.m. service.

Bascomb Preschool is able to acquire books and classroom materials with the 'scholastic dollars' that we earn at our fairs. Check out our 'enrichment classroom' that is filled with toys and manipulatives that the children can use to enrich their classroom experiences that they receive at BUMP. Also, the Bascomb Preschool library now has over 2000 books in its inventory, most of which were earned through Scholastic book fair sales.

October Happenings at Bascomb Preschool

The preschool will hold its annual Fall Craft and Pumpkin auction during October. The preschool parents volunteer to provide hand made items that will be up for Auction starting on **Oct. 11** *@* **9am** and ending **Oct. 25th at 1:15pm**.

This is the school's biggest fundraiser of the year, and proceeds will go toward the purchases of playground chips to keep the area at the proper fall to depth ratio. These chips are typically in need of replenishing after about 2-3 years.

Also, you may see the parking lot decorated with trunks once again, this time on the morning of October 31st when the preschool students will celebrate with each other and their families when parent volunteers set up their trunks for trick or treating for our BUMP children.
