

October 29—Stewardship Campaign 2024 "Investing With Your Treasures" Luke 21: 1-4

This coming Sunday, October 29th, we will have one of the shortest readings from the preaching calendar. The passage is Luke 21:1-4 and is the final theme of our Stewardship series concerning our treasures. We will also hear from another couple from our congregation about their willingness to give to Bascomb. Then next week on November 5th, we will have our final Sunday for our Stewardship series and you will be asked to turn in your pledge card for 2024. After that service, we will all recess to the Fellowship Hall where we will have a Celebration Lunch together celebrating the opportunity to give back to God through our church, so we can continue our church's 193-year history of serving God and our community.

Our passage for Sunday is from Luke 21 and is a familiar passage. It is where Jesus and the disciples are outside of the Temple courts during the Passover season. Jesus was standing near where the worshippers were in order to put their offerings into the metal containers. Jesus noticed how the rich stepped forward and threw in large amounts of coins. But then he also noticed a widow step forward to throw in two small copper coins.

It was evident to everyone there that day that the widow had offered such a small offering to the Temple compared to what had been given before her offering. Many may not have even noticed the widow if it wasn't for Jesus speaking out to the crowd about what she had given compared to the others. I look forward to seeing everyone on Sunday so we can hear Jesus once again share what the widow had really done that day.
