

February 18, 2024—Spring Training in the OT—1 "Noah—A Covenant of Love" Genesis 9: 8-17

This week is one of my most favorite times of the year. Major League baseball teams will be reporting to their Spring Training sites in preparation for the upcoming 2024 baseball season. Now some of you may be wondering what all of this has to do with our church, along with my sermons, and Scripture readings. Well, let me explain.
