February 25, 2024—Spring Training in the OT—2
“Abram—What’s In a Name?” Genesis 17: 1-8, 15-17

Or was it what you did for a living, what type a car you drove, or maybe the type of clothes you would like to wear? Then there’s this, how long did you have that nickname? A couple of years, maybe just through high school or maybe all of your life.
