

BEAT Grant Approved

In 2023, some members at Bascomb became aware that the North Georgia Conference had established a fund called the BEAT Grant. These grant funds were to be used primarily to expand outreach activities in the local churches. We began preparing an application almost a year ago and after several revisions our application was finalized and submitted at the end of 2023. Bascomb was notified by the BEAT Team on February 27, 2024 that our grant application was approved for \$41,480. This money is to be used to begin programs at Bascomb that will attract 55+ year old adults to Bascomb. These new programs will also benefit our current members. We will need lots of help both in planning and starting these new programs so please consider volunteering your time and talents.



March 17, 2024 "Wanting to See Jesus" John 12: 20-26

Have you ever met someone famous? Maybe a sports star? Maybe a movie star? Or maybe even a musical star? I have met a couple of "famous" people over the years. Probably the wildest one would be Richard Kiel. I was working for a small movie company called "American International Pictures" and we had a movie called "Force Ten from Navarone."

One of the stars from the movie came by our office to go on a press tour. I went out to my car to go to lunch when a car pulled up. Imagine my surprise when Richard Kiel, this 7 foot, 2 inch gentleman, pulled himself out of the car. I introduced myself and we shook hands, and he went on his way.

All we have to do is to talk, pray, sing, laugh, cry, and whatever other way we can come up with and Jesus will hear us. And then in his own time, through the power of the Holy Spirit, Jesus will speak and we can listen to what Jesus will say to us in return.
