May 26, 2024—Trinity Sunday John 3: 1-17 "Be Bold"

When I was asked to preach on Sunday, I didn't think much before I said yes. It was a couple weeks away, and I figured that I would have plenty of time to sit down and prepare a sermon. I would have time to find images, and maybe a video to help with the message. I'd be able to look at the scripture and spend several weeks with it, and I'd deliver a sermon that was strong and powerful.

Last Sunday, as I woke up and got ready to go to church it dawned on me. "Your preaching next Sunday". I hadn't read the scripture, I hadn't looked for imagery and video. I hadn't even looked at what the reading was going to be. I arrived at church, and ran into Pastor Dan, and asked him the question, I'm sure he was hoping to hear from the guy who was filling in for him in a week. "What is the reading that we are doing next Sunday?" With the confidence of a pastor who prepares his sermons well in advance, he told me it was Trinity Sunday, and told me the passage. We talked a little bit about it, and in the end he said to me "Be Bold".

I have an interesting relationship with that statement, which you may get to hear about on Sunday, but what is important now is that it has stuck with me. So we are going to **be bold** today. We are entering a new time with our church, and we need to be bold in the opportunity that we have in front of us. As Jesus tells Nicodemus, "*We must be born again*". I believe that Bascomb has been born again, and now it is our time to take our ministry to the world.
